## TWO LOCAL WALKS DURING THE SCHOOL HOLIDAYS

Duffield Parish Council would like to invite you to join their two free Saturday Community Walks

Both walks start at 10am. All children must be accompanied

Please bring a picnic/snacks and drinks, wear suitable clothing and shoes, bring suncream and/or a waterproof depending on our changeable Derbyshire weather!

Unaccompanied adults will also enjoy these walks.

## Walk 1 - Saturday 27th July 2024

We'll meet at the Parish notice boards by the White Hart on the A6 (Town Street). We'll then walk uphill to Quardon via Cumberhill, then by permissive path to Bunkers Hill, where we'll enjoy unparalleled views over the Derwent Valley, whilst enjoying our drinks and picnic. We'll return to Duffield via Burleywood Farm & Broadway.

The distance for this enjoyable walk is 4 km (2.5 miles).

## Walk 2 – 17<sup>th</sup> August 2024

We'll again meet at the Parish notice boards by the White Hart on the A6 (Town Street). For this walk we'll follow the Ecclesbourne River and then the Ecclesbourne Valley Railway westwards (with any luck a heritage railway train will run past for our benefit). Next we'll go uphill to Hazelwood Hall Farm, turning eastwards along the Chevin for our drinks and picnic stop, again with good views of the area.

We'll return to Duffield joining the Midshires Way walking down past Chevin golf club.

The distance for this walk is 6km (3.5 miles).
